ARRIVING TO BARCELONA

For your convenience, we have decided to help you a little with orientation in the city of Barcelona, where you are about to take an Erasmus+ training with us. So, if you happen not to be used to travelling or are about to visit Barcelona for the first time, do not worry about getting lost and profit out of our "directions handbook" prepared by ITC International for you!

The Barcelona airport El Prat is located about 18 km/11 miles from the city centre (Plaça de Cataluyna). It takes approximately 25 – 30 minutes (40 minutes in heavy traffic) to reach the centre by taxi and about 30 minutes by public transport (bus or train). The cheapest way to get to the city is by bus or train.

Bus:

- 1) Buy a ticket from the vending ticket machine, next to the bus stop or in the bus.
- 2) Take bus A1 (from T1) or A2 (from T2) or bus num. 46
- 3) For bus num. 46: from the Airport bus stop to the Plaça Espanya bus station.

or

For buses A1 or A2: from the Airport bus stop to Plaça Espanya or Plaça Catalunya.

There you can transfer to Metro *Line L1* • and go to the station *L1*, *L2* • Universitat.



Note: Punch your ticket when you enter the bus or in the metro/city train station, validation boxes are located inside the stations in front of the tourniquets. Don't forget to take your ticket back when it comes out from the validation boxes. You will need it in order to open the exit door when leaving.

Taxi: The taxi service number is +34 93 303 3033. Getting to the city centre will cost you around € 25,00 from the T2 and around € 30,00 from the T1.



GETTING AROUND BARCELONA

Barcelona has a very good public transportation system. The metro, city trains (cercanías), trams and buses. To move around town, we recommend using public transport over driving or taking a taxi.

Where to buy tickets:

- vending ticket machines
- ▶ on-line: on this web page and get 10 % off (3 or 5-day ticket only).
- ▶ Barcelona Public Transportation offices located at Metro stations
- ► A1/A2 bus drivers only for the airport bus to the city centre



Public Transportation Tickets:

€ 2.20 - one-way ticket (transfers not allowed) for airport bus num.46


€ 5.90 - one-way airport bus ticket for buses A1 or A2 (€10,20 return ticket)

€ 10.20 - A multi-person travel card valid for 10 intermodal journeys (zone 1 only!)

€ 35.40 - 5-day Barcelona travel card

(cheaper if you buy it on-line includes metro (L9) service travel between city centre and the airport).

NOTA BENE: We recommend you do not book anything before you get the confirmation form ITC about your course – you need to have our course place registration confirmation before booking your flight and accommodation.








GETTING TO CLICK & DO (ITC COURSES IN BARCELONA)
